WHEREAS, assessments for drainage maintenance also are permitted by R.C. 6137.02; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer seeks to establish a drainage maintenance fund for said Subdivision and to fully execute its powers and duties thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer has prepared a Special Assessment Worksheet, which is attached and marked as <u>amended</u> "Exhibit A", which apportions necessary charges for drainage maintenance among the Subdivision's benefited parcel owners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

A drainage maintenance fund for Estates of Bath Extension, located in Bath Township, Council District 1, is hereby established.

SECTION 2

Owners of parcels within Estates of Bath Extension shall be assessed for drainage maintenance per the attached <u>amended</u> Special Assessment Worksheet, Exhibit A hereof. Each assessment is proportional to the estimated benefit to the respective parcel.

SECTION 3

Pursuant to O.R.C. § 6137.03 the Clerk of Council shall certify the attached assessments to the County Fiscal Officer for placement on the next succeeding tax duplicate to be collected and paid.
