A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations by \$184,000.00 within the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund for the salaries and benefits line items in the General Operating Budget for the period of 01/05/09 through 12/31/09, for the County Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2008-485 appropriated funds within the 2009 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, \$184,000.00 in original appropriations in the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund require an adjustment between the salaries and benefits accounts in order to provide for staff changes; and

WHEREAS, the required adjustments in original appropriations will not increase the overall appropriation of funds from the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the adjustment of appropriations in the aforementioned Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Appropriations are hereby adjusted as follows:


SECTION 5
