An amended Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions for school based mental health responder services, for the period 1/1/09 through ~~6/30/09~~ 12/31/09 in the amount of ~~\$40,100.00~~, \$40,500.00, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 4, 2009, has awarded a contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions for case management services, for the period 1/1/09 through ~~6/30/09~~, 12/31/09, in the amount of ~~\$40,100.00~~, \$40,500.00 for the County of Summit Juvenile Court; and

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions for school based mental health responder services, for the period 1/1/09 through ~~6/30/09~~ 12/31/09 in the amount of ~~\$40,100.00~~, \$40,500.00 for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, is hereby confirmed, and the County Executive is authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing a necessary contract for the Juvenile Court.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4


