**A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$131,600.00, for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09, for the Summit County Law Library as prescribed by the recently enacted State of Ohio Substitute House Bill 420, for the Executive's Department of Law, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the Summit County Law Library functions under a county law library association board of trustees as a private non-profit entity with County of Summit support formerly set forth in Section 3375.49 of the Ohio Revised Code, including reimbursement of a portion of the cost of compensation for the law library director and assistant directors; and

WHEREAS, Substitute House Bill (HB) 420, which passed in December 2008, effectively repealed Section 3375.49, making the County responsible for reimbursing the full cost of compensation for the law library director and assistant directors in 2009; and

WHEREAS, this Council has found and determined, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate funds in the amount of \$131,600.00 for the cost of compensation for the law library director and assistant directors for the aforementioned reasons; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

SECTION 2

The County Fiscal Office is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within appropriations.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it will immediately provide the necessary appropriation for the Summit County Law Library.

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SECTION 4

Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 5
