A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of a Title II Formula Grant from the Ohio Department of Youth Services to the County of Summit Juvenile Court for a Juvenile Court Diversion Program in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09, and appropriating these Diversion Program grant funds for the grant period, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a Title II Formula Grant in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no match requirement for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09, from the Ohio Department of Youth Services to establish a court based diversion program with a focus on minority youth; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant and that the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept award of a Title II Formula Grant to the County of Summit Juvenile Court by the Ohio Department of Youth Services for the Juvenile Court Diversion Program, in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09.

SECTION 2

The Title II Formula Grant funds are hereby appropriated for the Juvenile Court Diversion Program for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09 as follows:

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 6
