7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Tri-County Jobs for Ohio’s Graduates, for Virtual Summer Work**
9 **Experience services, for the period 5/1/20 through 8/31/20, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$50,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes entering into an agreement with Tri-County
14 Jobs for Ohio’s Graduates (“JOG”) to provide Virtual Summer Work Experience (“VSWE”)
15 services for 500 youth, aged 16 through 17, from public assistance recipient families; and

17 WHEREAS, JOG will conduct participant recruitment and eligibility and will develop
18 and deliver up to three tracks of Virtual certificate-based work readiness training; and

19
20 WHEREAS, the proposed training tracks include “Certificate of Mastery through Skills
21 to Succeed”, “Jobs for America’s Graduates Soft Skills for Success” and “Summit County Model
22 on Employer Engagement and Leadership;” and

24 WHEREAS, each certificate program will take 20 to 25 hours to complete and will
25 include virtual classrooms through the Zoom platform, as well as self-paced homework
26 activities; and

28 WHEREAS, participants will select two of the three tracks and will earn \$250.00 for each
29 track completed, for a potential maximum of \$500.00 to be earned per participant; and

31 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 22, 2020, awarded a
32 professional service contract with JOG for VSWE services, for the period 5/1/20 through
33 8/31/20, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that the aforementioned professional service contract with JOG is necessary and in the best
37 interest of the County of Summit;

39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
40 of Ohio, that:

44 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tri-County
45 Jobs for Ohio’s Graduates, for Virtual Summer Work Experience services, for the period 5/1/20
46 through 8/31/20, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County
47 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract and any other
48 necessary related documents.


