A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-359, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a Fiscal Year 2019 Treatment Drug Courts grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMSHA") for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project, in the amount \$354,321.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/19 through 9/29/20; and

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation, wishes to enter into a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, to be funded by the SAMSHA grant; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 25, 2020, awarded a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1
