7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Tyler Technologies for five years of maintenance of the New World**  
9 **Computer Aided Dispatch Platform, pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(14) of the Codified**  
10 **Ordinances of the County of Summit, in a total amount of \$1,752,610.00, and ratifying the**  
11 **payment for the first-half of Year 2 of said maintenance, in the amount of \$263,841.00, for**  
12 **the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety and**  
13 **the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-209, which  
16 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tyler  
17 Technologies for the acquisition, installation and one year of maintenance of the Tyler  
18 Technologies' New World Computer Aided Dispatch Platform (the "Tyler CAD System"),  
19 pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(14) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, in a total  
20 amount not to exceed \$3,418,994.00; and

22 WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a professional service contract with Tyler  
23 Technologies for five years of maintenance of the Tyler CAD System, pursuant to Section  
24 177.07(a)(14) of the Codified Ordinances, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,752,610.00, which  
25 includes the first-year of maintenance at no cost to the County; and

27 WHEREAS, the cost of said contract will be split between the participating communities  
28 using the Tyler CAD System at a rate of approximately:

38 WHEREAS, it is further necessary to ratify the payment to Tyler Technologies, in the  
39 amount of \$263,841.00, for the first-half of Year 2 of said maintenance; and

41 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 25, 2020, awarded a  
42 professional service contract with Tyler Technologies for five years of maintenance of the New  
43 World Computer Aided Dispatch Platform, pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(14) of the Codified  
44 Ordinances of the County of Summit, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,752,610.00, subject to  
45 confirmation by County Council; and

47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Tyler Technologies is necessary and in the best  
49 interest of the County of Summit;

51 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tyler  
7 Technologies for five years of maintenance of the New World Computer Aided Dispatch  
8 Platform (the "Tyler CAD System"), pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(14) of the Codified  
9 Ordinances of the County of Summit, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,752,610.00, is hereby  
10 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service  
11 contract and any other necessary related documents.

13 SECTION 2

15 The payment to Tyler Technologies, in the amount of \$263,841.00, for the first half of  
16 Year 2 of maintenance of the Tyler CAD System, is hereby ratified.

18 SECTION 3

20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
21 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
22 provide for necessary maintenance to the Tyler CAD System.

24 SECTION 4

26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

30 SECTION 5

32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
35 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
