An Ordinance enacting Section 169.18A of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Employees Serving as Summit County Precinct Election Officials" to authorize employees of the County to volunteer as precinct election officials, and to authorize appointing authorities of the County of Summit to assign employees to serve as precinct election officials, under the supervision of the Board of Elections and amending Sections 169.02(a), 169.22(a), and 169.22 (f) to address changes to Election Judge Leave, for the Executive's Department of Human Resources, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Board of Elections ("the Board") is charged with the responsibility of holding elections pursuant to section 3501.11 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board appoints precinct election officials to conduct operations at polling places throughout the county pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 3501.22; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code section 3501.28(F)(1)(a) provides that any employee of the County may serve as a precinct election official on the day of an election without loss of the employee's regular compensation for that day so long as the employee's appointing authority permits leave with pay for this service in accordance with a resolution setting forth the terms and conditions for that leave passed by the board of county commissioners; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that a sufficient number of precinct election officials are available to conduct operations at each of the polling locations established by the Board it is necessary to permit such employees to volunteer to be assigned to work as precinct election officials, and it may be necessary to authorize County appointing authorities to assign employees to work as precinct election officials under the supervision of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to enact Section 169.18A of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Employees Serving as Summit County Precinct Election Officials" to authorize employees of the County to volunteer to be assigned to work as precinct election officials, and to authorize County appointing authorities to assign employees to work as precinct election officials, under the supervision of the Board and to further define the work schedule and compensation for employees assigned; and

WHEREAS, it is further necessary to amend Sections 169.02(a), 169.22(a), and 169.22(f) to address changes to Election Judge Leave to differentiate the process for employees who reside in other to counties and wish to volunteer to work as precinct election officials for their county board of elections; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to enact Section 169.18A entitled "Employees Serving as Summit County Precinct Election Officials" and amend Sections 169.02(a), 169.22(a), and 169.22(f) to address changes to Election Judge Leave for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 Section 169.18A of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Employees Serving as Summit County Precinct Election Officials" is hereby enacted as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

· SECTION 2

Sections 169.02(a), 169.22(a), and 169.22(f) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, are hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 3

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to assist the Summit County Board of Elections with its responsibility to conduct elections under section 3501.11 of the Ohio Revised Code and to provide for a sufficient number of precinct election officials under Section 3501.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

INTRODUCED

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
