18 19 20	WHEREAS, the County induces economic growth by exempting certain taxes imposed on industry where said industry creates or retains jobs within a certified enterprise zone; and
21 22 23	WHEREAS, Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. has submitted an application to receive tax abatements through the Ohio Enterprise Zone Program to the City of Cuyahoga Falls; and
24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. intends to relocate \$19,432,911.62 in machinery, equipment, and inventory from its facility at 55 S. Main Street, Munroe Falls, Ohio 44262 to consolidate its Summit County operations at 220 and 238 Marc Drive, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223; and
29 30 31	WHEREAS, Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. intends to preserve the jobs of its current 125 employees in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio and relocate 84 employees from Munroe Falls, Ohio to Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio and retain 15 jobs in Munroe Falls, Ohio; and
32 33 34 35 36	WHEREAS, the City Council of Cuyahoga Falls has authorized its Mayor to enter into an enterprise zone agreement with Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. to offer tax incentives for an eligible project within the zone, subject to approval by the County Executive; and

8	investments within the City of Cuyahoga Falls Enterprise Zone in Council District 3. The
9	agreement will provide an exemption on: Real Property Tax – 75% for ten (10) years, a copy of
10	which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and
11	revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said enterprise zone agreement and not
12	substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the

17	This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
18	welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
