A Resolution declaring the month of February 2020 as Black History Month in Summit County, recognizing African Americans and the achievements they have made throughout the nation's history, as well as the struggles and roadblocks they have faced and continue to face, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency

WHEREAS, with the Civil Rights Movement and a growing awareness of black identity, Black History Month evolved to an annual celebration of achievements by black Americans and a time for recognizing the central role of African Americans in U.S. history; and

WHEREAS, the unforgettable contributions that African Americans have made to our nation and county, as artists, scientists, educators, business people, influential thinkers, members of the faith community, athletes, and political and governmental leaders, and all other walks of life, reflects the greatness of the United States and Summit County; and

WHEREAS, it is important that our community honor those who fought to ensure that every member of society is treated equally under the law by recognizing those who came before us and created this history.

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that February 2020 be declared Black History Month in Summit County, and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in this acknowledgement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The month of February 2020 is hereby declared Black History Month in Summit County, and the residents of Summit County are encouraged to join in this acknowledgement and recognize the role that racial diversity plays in strengthening our community.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents and employees of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately declaring February 2020 as Black History Month in Summit County.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
