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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice**
9 **Services of a Drug Law Enforcement Fund grant, for the period 2/1/15 through 6/30/15, in**
10 **the amount of \$104,175.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$34,725.00, and**
11 **appropriating funds in the amount of \$138,900.00, for Fiscal Year 2015, for the Sheriff, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services
15 ("ODPS-OCJS") has awarded the County Sheriff's Office a Drug Law Enforcement Fund
16 ("DLEF") grant, for the period 2/1/15 through 6/30/15, in the amount of \$104,175.00 with a 25%
17 local cash match requirement of \$34,725.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, this DLEF grant will fund a countywide drug unit task force which will
20 specifically target the manufacture, distribution and acquisition of illegal drugs in Summit
21 County; and

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23 WHEREAS, the local cash match will be provided by funds from the Sheriff's Summit
24 County Drug Unit checking account; and

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26 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the amount of \$138,900.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
30 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned DLEF
31 grant from the ODPS-OCJS, and to appropriate grant funds and the local cash match;

41 through 6/30/15, in the amount of \$104,175.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of
