7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year policing contract with**
8 **the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority, in Council District 1, pursuant to which the**
9 **County Sheriff will provide the Authority with 3,757.16 Sheriff's Deputy/Sergeant hours,**
10 **for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in exchange for payment by the Authority, in the**
11 **amount of \$239,462.61 for the one-year term, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority ("AMHA") has requested that the
14 County of Summit enter into a one-year policing contract pursuant to which the Sheriff will
15 provide 3,757.16 deputy/sergeant hours, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, and

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17 WHEREAS, AMHA has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$239,462.61 during the
18 one-year term of the contract; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
22 Executive to execute the aforementioned policing contract with AMHA;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that;

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a one year policing contract with
30 the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority ("AMHA"), in Council District 1, pursuant to which
31 the County Sheriff will provide AMHA with 3,757.16 deputy/sergeant hours, for the period
32 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in exchange for payment by AMHA in the amount of \$239,462.61 for
33 the one-year term of the contract.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
39 providing necessary policing for AMHA, in Council District 1, effective 1/1/15.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
