A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for the renewal (third of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections services, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$5,581,202.18, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2011-501, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract to Oriana House, Inc., for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and residential community corrections programs, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in an amount not to exceed \$5,320,118.46, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index or three percent, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2013-015, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the renewal (first of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections program services, in an amount not to exceed \$5,437,436.86; and

WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-058, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of the renewal (second of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections program services, in an amount not to exceed \$5,489,832.69; and; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to execute the renewal (third of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections program services, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$5,581,202.18; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2015, the Board of Control approved a professional service contract renewal (third of four) to Oriana House, Inc., for community corrections program services, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the renewal (third of four) of a community corrections service agreement with Oriana House, Inc., is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
