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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement with**
8 **the Village of Mogadore for the provision of services by the Sheriff's Special Weapons and**
9 **Tactics Team, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, County Council has previously adopted Resolution Nos. 2009-157 and
12 2012-092, which authorized mutual aid agreements between the County of Summit and Summit
13 County communities concerning the County Sheriff's Special Weapons and Tactics ("SWAT")
14 Team; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County and the Village of Mogadore wish to execute a Mutual Aid
17 Agreement for the provision of services by the Sheriff's SWAT Team; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
21 Executive to execute the aforementioned Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Mogadore
22 for the aforementioned reasons;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that;

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement with the
30 Village of Mogadore for the provision of services by the County Sheriff's Special Weapons and
31 Tactics ("SWAT") Team.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
37 authorizing a necessary Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Mogadore for the provision
38 of services by the Sheriff's SWAT Team.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
