7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a five-year HVAC**
8 **maintenance contract for the Juvenile Detention Center, for an estimated total cost not to**
9 **exceed \$210,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services – Physical**
10 **Plants, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a five-year full HVAC
16 maintenance contract for the Juvenile Detention Center, in Council District 2; and

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18 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is attached as Exhibit A; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
22 advertise for bids for a five-year full HVAC maintenance contract for the Juvenile Detention
23 Center, in Council District 2;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a five-year full HVAC
31 maintenance contract for the Juvenile Detention Center, in Council District 2, for an estimated
32 total cost not to exceed \$210,000.00.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
37 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
38 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for a five-year full HVAC maintenance contract for
39 the Juvenile Detention Center in Council District 2.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
