7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract renewal (second of five) with the Akron Area YMCA, for child care services, for**
9 **the period 7/1/15 through 6/30/16, in an amount not to exceed \$67,346.58, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 25, 2015, awarded a
13 professional service contract renewal (second of five) with The Young Men's Christian
14 Association of Akron, Inc., dba Akron Area YMCA, for drop-in child care services at the
15 OhioMeansJobs facility, fka The Job Center, for all regardless of income, for the period 7/1/15
16 through 6/30/16, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the contract renewal is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract renewal (second of
27 five) with The Young Men's Christian Association of Akron, Inc., dba Akron Area YMCA, for
28 drop-in child care services at the OhioMeansJobs facility, fka The Job Center, for all regardless
29 of income, for the period 7/1/15 through 6/30/16, in an amount not to exceed \$67,346.58, is
30 hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract
31 renewal.

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 provide for drop-in child care services effective 7/1/15.

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
