7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio**
8 **Department of Job and Family Services for the receipt of Title IV-E funds by the Court of**
9 **Common Pleas Juvenile Division, for the period 7/1/15 to 6/30/17, for the Court of Common**
10 **Pleas Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division is a subrecipient and
13 subgrantee of funds to administer programs under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act (“Title
14 IV-E funds”), with the State of Ohio serving as the grantee and recipient of said funds from the
15 federal government; and

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17 WHEREAS, as a condition of the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division receiving
18 Title IV-E funds, the State of Ohio has requested that the County enter into a subgrant agreement
19 with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, setting forth the rights and responsibilities
20 of each party as they pertain to the receipt of Title IV-E funds, for the period 7/1/15 to 6/30/17;

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23 WHEREAS, the County of Summit enters into similar subgrant agreements for the
24 Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services and Child Support Enforcement Agency;
25 and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the
29 subgrant agreement;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
32 State of Ohio, that:

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34 SECTION 1

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36 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the
37 Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the receipt of Title IV-E funds by the Court of
38 Common Pleas Juvenile Division for the period 7/1/15 to 6/30/17.

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40 SECTION 2

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
43 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately
44 authorizing the execution of the subgrant agreement to ensure timely receipt of said Title IV-E
45 funds.

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47 SECTION 3

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49 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
50 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
51 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
