WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with The University of Akron for instructor technician services for the Summit County Special Operations Response Team ("SORT") Executive Committee with certifying classes and paying instructors for conducting, facilitating and administering trainings, in an amount not to exceed \$29,400.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such agreement.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for instructor technician services in 2015.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
