NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Local 1032 (Clerical and Technical Unit) and Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO and the County Executive and the County Engineer, for the period 4/1/15 through 3/31/18.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between Local 1032 (Clerical and Technical Unit) and Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Executive and the County Engineer.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
