A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Special Services Agreement with the City of Akron to perform employee benefit management services for the City's employee benefit plans, for the period 5/1/15 through 12/31/15, for total amount not to exceed \$40,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the City of Akron have negotiated a Special Services Agreement pursuant to which the County will perform employee benefit management services for the City's employee benefit plans, for the period 5/1/15 through 12/31/15, in exchange for payment by the City of hourly rates in a total amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 over the term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned Special Services Agreement with the City of Akron;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Special Services Agreement pursuant to which the County will perform employee benefit management services for the City's employee benefit plans, for the period 5/1/15 through 12/31/15, in exchange for payment by the City of hourly rates in a total amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 over the term of the Agreement.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing the Executive to execute a necessary Special Services Agreement with the City of Akron to perform employee benefit management services for the City's employee benefit plans.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
