7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a grant application and any**  
8 **other necessary documents to accept a grant from Ohio Public Works Commission, with**  
9 **the City of New Franklin as lead applicant, for the State Route 93 Widening Project, in the**  
10 **City of New Franklin, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$50,000.00, for the Engineer,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, the County Engineer concludes that there is a public need to widen State  
14 Route 93, designated as the State Route 93 Widening Project (“the Project”), in the City of New  
15 Franklin in Council District 7; and

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17 WHEREAS, the County of Summit is eligible, with the City of New Franklin as lead  
18 applicant, to acquire Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement  
19 Program (“LTIP”) grant funds for the Project; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to  
23 execute a grant application and any other necessary documents for the Project to authorize the  
24 expenditure of up to \$50,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds for said  
25 improvement;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to execute an Ohio Public Works grant application  
33 and any other documents necessary to accept a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission  
34 of Local Transportation Improvement Program (“LTIP”) funds, with the City of New Franklin as  
35 lead applicant, for the purpose of widening State Route 93, designated as the State Route 93  
36 Widening Project, in the City of New Franklin, in Council District 7.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 The terms of said application shall allocate the cost of the Project among the following  
41 participants, with the County of Summit’s proportional share (Item A) not to exceed \$50,000.00,  
42 and with the other participant’s shares (Items B, C, and D) covering the remainder of the  
43 \$1,382,400.00 estimated project cost in amounts approximately equal to the following:

4 SECTION 3

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6 The expenditure of up to \$ 50,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds as  
7 the County of Summit's share of the cost of the Project is hereby authorized.

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9 SECTION 4

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11 The County Executive is authorized to execute said grant application and other  
12 documents necessary to apply for and accept the aforementioned grant funds only for the Ohio  
13 Public Works Program Year 30 (2015-2016), with further authorization required for any future  
14 grant applications for the State Route 93 Widening Project.

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16 SECTION 5

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18 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the  
19 County Engineer, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said grant  
20 application.

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22 SECTION 6

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24 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
25 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the  
26 County to obtain grant funds for an immediately needed improvement project.

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28 SECTION 7

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30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
31 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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34 SECTION 8

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36 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
37 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
38 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
39 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
40 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
