WHEREAS, it will also be necessary for funds to be appropriated in order to complete payment to J.W. Didato Electric for services rendered in performing the temporary and permanent repairs; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the Ohio Building Electric Service Repair constitutes an emergency under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to enter into an agreement with J.W. Didato Electric as he determines necessary to complete the Ohio Building Electric Service Repair without having to comply with the competitive bidding process and to further appropriate the funds necessary to complete the repairs;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The Council hereby finds and determines that the aforementioned Ohio Building Electric Service Repair constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3).

SECTION 2

As a result of the emergency circumstances, this Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into an agreement with J.W. Didato Electric, without complying with the competitive bidding procedures outlined in Chapter 177, in order to perform necessary repairs, in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00.
