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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

It is necessary and in the best interests of the County to acquire Seasons Commerce Center Sanitary Sewer Extension Project and Seasons Road Sanitary Sewer Phase Three, designated Sanitary Improvements No. 1646 and 1539-3 respectively (collectively the "Project"), as constructed by John A. Shutsa and Associates, Inc., ("Shutsa"), and as financed by the County, and the acquisition of the Project is hereby confirmed by this Council.

SECTION 2

In accordance with the Development Agreement previously authorized by County Council in Res. No. 2011-405, and in accordance with and the Petition to the Council of the County of Summit executed by Shutsa attached as Exhibit A. The cost of the Project financed by the County shall be specially assessed against the parcels as stated in Exhibit B.

SECTION 3

The assessment amount for the Project in the amount of \$400,765.63 is hereby confirmed by this Council, and said amount shall be final and conclusive ("Final Assessment").

SECTION 4

The Final Assessment for the Project in the total amount of \$400,765.63 shall be apportioned to the properties within the Project boundaries as stated in Exhibit B and is hereby certified to the Fiscal Officer to be placed on the tax list and duplicate for collection in semi-annual installments over 20 years at the rate of interest not to exceed the rate of the Ohio Water Development Authority Loan used to finance the Project costs.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately ensure the certification of assessments for the Project to the Fiscal Officer for collection in accordance with Section 6117.33 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
