7 **A Resolution setting a hearing on October 5, 2015 at 4:30 p.m. in Council Chambers for**
8 **objections to the tentative assessment or to the boundaries of the assessment district of the**
9 **Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948, in the Township of**
10 **Springfield and Village of Mogadore, for the Department of Environmental Services, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council approved the detailed plans and specifications for the
14 Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948 ("Project") in Resolution
15 No. 2015-271; and,

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17 WHEREAS, the County Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent
18 information, including the detailed plans, specifications, estimate of cost and tentative
19 assessment of the Project, that the Project is necessary for the preservation and promotion of the
20 public health and welfare, and is in the best interest of the County of Summit;

22 WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sec. §6117.06(E), this Council must
23 designate a time and place for objections to the Project, the tentative assessment, or to the
24 boundaries of the assessment district to be heard by this Council, the date of that hearing being
25 not less than twenty-four days after the date of the first publication of the notice of the hearing;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

31
32 The Columbine Service Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Q-948 ("Project"),
33 with its nature, location, route, and termini as described in Exhibits A (map) and B (list of
34 assessed parcels) attached to this Resolution, is necessary for the preservation and promotion of
35 the public health and welfare.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 The plans, specifications, estimate of cost, and tentative assessment of the Project shall be
40 on file at the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, 2525 State Road, Cuyahoga
41 Falls, Ohio 44223, where they may be examined.

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43 SECTION 3

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45 The tentative assessment for the Project in the amount of \$2,310,000.00 shall be assessed
46 on the properties listed in Exhibit B, however, no assessment shall exceed the sum of \$15,000.00
47 per benefit per lateral sewer connection. The remaining Project costs above the collective
48 assessed amount shall be contributed by the County from other available funds.
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4 SECTION 4

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6 A hearing shall be set on October 5, 2015 at 4:30 p.m., located in Council Chambers, 175
7 S. Main Street, Seventh Floor, Akron, Ohio 44308, where objections to the Project, the tentative
8 assessment, or to the boundaries of the assessment district shall be heard by this Council.

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10 SECTION 5

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12 The proper notices of the hearing shall be made in accordance with Ohio Revised Code
13 Section §6117.06(E).

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15 SECTION 6

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17 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
18 of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to provide for the immediate
19 construction of sanitary sewage facilities in the Township of Springfield and Village of
20 Mogadore needed to abate a health nuisance.

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22 SECTION 7

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24 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
25 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
26 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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28 SECTION 8

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30 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
31 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
32 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
33 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
34 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
