7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the purchase of air**
8 **monitoring equipment, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,672.00, for the**
9 **Executive's Department of Law Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public**
10 **Safety, Emergency Management Agency and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the purchase of air
16 monitoring equipment, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,672.00; and

18 WHEREAS, a copy of the technical specifications are attached as Exhibit A; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
22 advertise for bids for air monitoring equipment, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
23 \$110,672.00;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of air
31 monitoring equipment, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,672.00.

35 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
36 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for air monitoring equipment, the purchase of which
38 will be through homeland security grant funding, which expires January 31, 2016.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


