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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Tri-Tech Digital Forensics, for the purchase of 11 UFED4PC cellphone**  
9 **forensic software programs and a 5 day logical and physical extraction certification**  
10 **training for 20 students, in an amount not to exceed \$192,170.00, for the Executive's**  
11 **Department of Law, Insurance, and Risk Management- Division of Public Safety.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 9, 2015, awarded a  
14 professional service contract with Tri-Tech Digital Forensics, for the purchase of 11 UFED4PC  
15 cellphone forensic software programs and a 5 day logical and physical extraction certification  
16 training for 20 students, approved by the IT Board on 9/8/15, subject to confirmation of County  
17 Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
20 that the aforementioned purchase order with Tri-Tech Digital Forensics is necessary and in the  
21 best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tri-Tech  
29 Digital Forensics, for the purchase of 11 UFED4PC cellphone forensic software programs and a  
30 5 day logical and physical extraction certification training for 20 students, approved by the IT  
31 Board on 9/8/15, in an amount not to exceed \$192,170.00, is hereby confirmed and the County  
32 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
38 provide the necessary forensic software programs and training for the Executive's Department of  
39 Law, Insurance, and Risk Management- Division of Public Safety.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
