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7 **An Ordinance repealing Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,**  
8 **entitled “Information and Technology Board,” for the Office of Information Technology,**  
9 **and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended to repeal Chapter 146 of the  
12 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “Information and Technology Board”  
13 due to the creation of the Summit County Information Technology Board under Article VIII of  
14 the Charter of the County of Summit; and

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16 WHEREAS, the repeal of Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances will update, revise and  
17 clarify the procedure of purchasing information technology services and equipment following the  
18 passage of Resolution No. 2015-436; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
21 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to repeal Chapter 146 of the  
22 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as recommended by the Executive;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
25 State of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 Chapter 146 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit is hereby repealed in  
30 its entirety.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 The Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately  
36 repealing Chapter 146 in order to immediately update and revise the County’s process of  
37 purchasing of data processing and information system technology.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect  
43 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
48 to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
