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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Fire Force, for air monitoring equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$63,798.00, for the**
9 **Executive's Department of Law, Insurance, and Risk Management- Division of Public**
10 **Safety, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-414, which authorized
13 the County Executive to advertise for bids for the purchase of air monitoring equipment, for an
14 estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,672.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 21, 2015, awarded a
17 purchase contract with Fire Force, for air monitoring equipment, in an amount not to exceed
18 \$63,798.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
21 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Fire Force is necessary and in the best of the
22 County; and

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24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Fire Force, for air
30 monitoring equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$63,798.00, is hereby confirmed and the
31 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 provide for the aforementioned air monitoring equipment needed for the County of Summit
38 Special Operations Response Team.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code
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


