7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year policing contract with**
8 **the County of Summit Public Health Adult Protective Services to provide two full-time**
9 **Sheriff's detectives and two one-shift vehicles, for the period 10/1/15 through 9/30/16, for**
10 **the amount of \$217,744.66, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Public Health Adult Protective Services wishes with
13 to enter into a policing contract with the County of Summit to provide two full-time Sheriff's
14 detectives and two one-shift vehicles, for a one-year term, from 10/1/15 through 9/30/16; and

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16 WHEREAS, APS has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$18,145.39 per month, for
17 a total of \$217,744.66, for the one-year term of the contract, from 10/1/15 through 9/30/16; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the aforementioned policing contract with APS is necessary and in the best interest of the
21 County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that;

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a one-year policing contract with
29 the County of Summit Public Health Adult Protective Services ("APS") to provide two full-time
30 Sheriff's detectives and two one-shift vehicles, for the period 10/1/15 through 9/30/16, for the
31 amount of \$217,744.66. APS has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$18,145.39 per month,
32 for a total of \$217,744.66, for the one-year term of the contract, from 10/1/15 through 9/30/16.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
38 providing necessary policing to APS effective 10/1/15.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
