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7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations, in the amount of \$42,000.00, within the**  
8 **Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Temporary Assistance to Need Families Grant fund for the**  
9 **Juvenile Division's Family Resource Center, for the Court of Common Pleas - Juvenile**  
10 **Division, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-446, which  
13 authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from  
14 the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services of a Federal Fiscal Year 2015  
15 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant to the County Summit Court of Common Pleas -  
16 Juvenile Division, for its Family Resource Center, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the  
17 amount of \$370,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating grant funds;

20 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust existing appropriations, in the amount of  
21 \$42,000.00, within the Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Temporary Assistance to Need Families Grant  
22 fund for the Juvenile Division's Family Resource Center in order to cover underestimated salary  
23 costs for the grant period; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to adjust existing appropriations, in the  
27 amount of \$42,000.00, within the Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Temporary Assistance to Need  
28 Families Grant fund for the Juvenile Division's Family Resource Center for the aforementioned  
29 reasons;


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15 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
