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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **professional service contract with JG3 Consulting, LLC, in an amount not to exceed**
9 **\$14,935.00 (a 42.7% cumulative increase), for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-133, which
12 confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract, as a Best
13 Practical Source, with JG3 Consulting, LLC, for pavement inspection services for the County
14 highway systems and Coventry Township roadway systems in an amount not to exceed
15 \$35,000.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on November 18, 2015, awarded
18 Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with JG3 Consulting, LLC, for additional
19 pavement inspection services in Springfield Township; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional services
30 contract with JG3 Consulting, Inc., for additional pavement inspection services in Springfield
31 Township, in amount not to exceed \$14,935.00 (42.7% increase) is hereby confirmed and the
32 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide pavement inspection services in Springfield Township.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
