7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for the renewal of a**
9 **maintenance agreement for the integrated assessment system software, for the period of**
10 **1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$197,210.00, for the Office of**
11 **Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held December 9, 2015, awarded a
14 professional service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for the
15 renewal of a maintenance agreement for the integrated assessment system software, approved by
16 the IT Board on 12/7/15, for the period of 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed
17 \$197,210.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Tyler Technologies, Inc. is necessary
21 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Tyler
29 Technologies, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for the renewal of the maintenance agreement for
30 the integrated assessment system software, approved by the IT Board on 12/7/15, for the period
31 1/1/16 through 12/31/16, in an amount not to exceed \$197,210.00, is hereby confirmed and the
32 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract.

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide the necessary maintenance to the integrated assessment system software effective 1/1/16.
