WHEREAS, the County of Summit is in receipt of carryover federal grant funds for its Home Weatherization Assistance Program ("HWAP") from various awards from the State of Ohio for Home Weatherization Assistance programs, which provide funding for necessary home improvements to low income citizens, including funds received through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, which were appropriated by Resolution Nos. 2009-246 and 2009-469; and

WHEREAS, the County is also in receipt of carryover grant funds for HWAP appropriated by Resolution Nos. 2009-008 and 2009-337, including funds received from the Area Agency on Aging for services to eligible elderly and disabled individuals and from First Energy to provide a variety of energy efficiency education and repair services to qualified residents; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of carryover grant funds available to the County's HWAP is \$2,992,684.89; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned grant funds;
