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7 **A Resolution appropriating federal carryover grant funds received from the Ohio**
8 **Department of Public Safety as a Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement**
9 **Act of 2000 grant, in the amount of \$6,250.46, with no local cash match requirement, for**
10 **the period ending 9/30/10, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety has awarded the County of Summit
13 Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act of 2000 ("Coverdell") grant, in the
14 amount of \$6,250.46, with no local cash match requirement, for the Medical Examiner for
15 "Forensic Pathology Training and Equipment," in order to provide funding for accreditation
16 training for Summit County forensic pathologists; and

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18 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2009-458 authorized the County Executive to execute any
19 documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant award and it is necessary to
20 appropriate grant funds for the period ending 9/30/10; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
23 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned
24 grant funds;

14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


