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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase**
8 **order with Shaw's Automotive for auto repairs for Sheriff's fleet vehicles as reasonable**
9 **reoccurring historical expenses and Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$150,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 3, 2010, has awarded a
13 super specific purchase contract for auto repairs for Sheriff's fleet vehicles, subject to
14 confirmation by County Council; and,

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16 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
17 the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
20 of Ohio, that:

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22 SECTION 1

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24 The award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order with Shaw's
25 Automotive for auto repairs for Sheriff's fleet vehicles as reasonable reoccurring historical
26 expenses and Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, is hereby
27 confirmed, and the County Executive is authorized to execute such a contract.

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29 SECTION 2

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31 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
32 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately
33 providing such auto repairs.

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35 SECTION 3

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37 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
38 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
39 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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41 SECTION 4

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43 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
44 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
45 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
46 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
47 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
