The Planning and Economic Development Committee of the Summit County Council has held a public hearing on March 22, 2010 at 4:30 p.m. in Council Chambers. The public was invited to make comments at said hearing and notice of such hearing with respect to the approval of the Bonds was published in *The Akron-Beacon Journal* on or before March 8, 2010.

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SECTION 2

This Council, as the applicable elected representative of the County under the Code, hereby approves the issuance of the Bonds by Franklin County, in the principal amount not to exceed \$212,600,000.00. It is anticipated that the proceeds of the Bonds will be used in part by Ohio Presbyterian Retirement Services, Inc. to finance the Project and that the balance of the proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Ohio Presbyterian Retirement Services, Inc. to fund health care facilities throughout the State of Ohio. This approval is intended to comply solely with the Code and does not constitute a finding by the County or this Council that Franklin County, Ohio Presbyterian Retirement Services, Inc. or any other party are in compliance with the legal requirements imposed upon them in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

SECTION 3

The County Executive, the County Fiscal Officer of the County and the Clerk of County Council are each hereby separately authorized to take any and all actions and to execute such financing statements, assignments, certificates and other instruments that may be necessary or appropriate, in the opinion of Benesch, Friedlander, Coplan & Aronoff LLP, as Bond Counsel and the Executive's Department of Law, in order to effect the issuance of the Bonds, the financing of the Project and the intent of this resolution.

SECTION 4

This Council finds and determines that the Bonds shall not be, and are not, general obligations, debt or bonded indebtedness of the County and the holders or owners of the Bonds shall not have the right to have excises or taxes levied by the County for the payment of principal of, or interest or premium, if any, on the Bonds. Such payment shall be made only from funds provided by Ohio Presbyterian Retirement Services, Inc.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the County, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective in order to authorize the Bonds as soon as practicable.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
