12 WHEREAS, EMA provides an annual allocation of \$108,900.00 to the Summit County
13 Hazardous Materials Program in order to support and sustain the County of Summit Special
14 Operations Response Teams, Hazmat Branch, Technical Rescue Branch and Water Rescue
15 Branch; and

17 WHEREAS, funds from 2009 allocation, in the amount of \$68,244.46, remain available
18 for services in 2010; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
21 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned

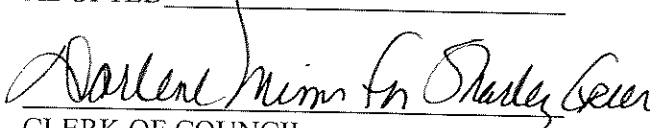
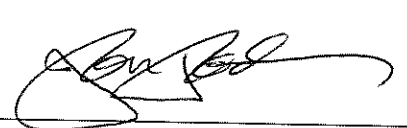
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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
