A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for improvement of Akron Peninsula Road, located in Boston Township and the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1, at an estimated total cost to the County of Summit not to exceed \$510,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, an improvement is proposed for approximately 1.16 miles of Akron Peninsula Road, from approximately 1,000 feet south of Truxell Road (C.H. 187) to Orchard Street (located approximately 500 feet south of State Route 303 in the Village of Peninsula), including pavement and shoulder resurfacing, said road section being located in Boston Township, and the Village of Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project is \$ 510,000.00, with \$475,000.00 of said cost to be funded by Public Lands Highway Discretionary funds, and with the remaining \$35,000.00 to be borne by the County of Summit, of which \$35,000.00 is 100% Engineer funds; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids for projects that are included in the Engineer's First Quarter Calendar Year 2010 Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that the County Executive be authorized to advertise for bids for the Akron Peninsula Road Improvement Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;
