11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2010-218, which authorized
12 the County Executive to hire an external person into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified
13 position of Senior Administrator-EXE, #89702, in the Department of Law, Public Safety
14 Division, to act as the Radio System Administrator for the county-wide 800 MHz radio system;

17 WHEREAS, adjustments to appropriations in the amount of \$50,000.00 in the 800MHz
18 Radio Maintenance Fund are needed to meet projected expenditures for Salaries and Benefits for
19 the Radio System Administrator for the balance of 2010; and

22 adjustments to appropriations are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
