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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a collective bargaining**
8 **agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State,**
9 **County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Fiscal Officer's Auditor's**
10 **Division, for the period 9/1/10 through 8/31/13, for the Executive and the Fiscal Officer,**
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the County
14 Fiscal Officer's Auditor's Division and Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American
15 Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, for the period 9/1/10 through 8/31/13;

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18 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
19 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to
20 execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
28 between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and
29 Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Fiscal Officer's Auditor's Division, for the
30 period 9/1/10 through 8/31/13.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of
36 immediately providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and
37 Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO,
38 and the County Fiscal Officer's Auditor's Division.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
51 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
