7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to pay Jeff Brasdovich the sum of \$3,174.50**
8 **for costs of repair and restoration to the basement and loss of his personal property**
9 **resulting from a sewer back-up at his residence on 7676 Kitner Blvd., Northfield, Ohio**
10 **44067, Council District 1, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, on August 14, 2010, a sewer backup occurred at the residence of Jeff
14 Brasdovich at 7676 Kitner Blvd., in the City of Northfield, Council District 1, and

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16 WHEREAS, the total value of personal property lost and repairs required from said
17 backup is valued at \$3,174.50, excluding costs of sanitizing and dry-out being paid under
18 Chapter 119A of the County of Summit's Codified Ordinances, and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
21 that authorizing the Executive to pay the sum of \$3,174.50 to Jeff Brasdovich is necessary and in
22 the best interest of the County;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to pay to Jeff Brasdovich the sum of
30 \$3,174.50 to reimburse him for the repair and restoration of his basement at 7676 Kitner Blvd.,
31 in the City of Northfield, and for the value of personal property lost in the sewer back-up on
32 August 14, 2010, and to prepare a release and other documents necessary to protect the interests
33 of the County with said reimbursement.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 The payment authorized in Section 1 shall be paid out of the Executive's Department of
38 Environmental Services' Sewer Fund, account number 50001-8510-61017.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
43 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will
44 immediately allow said payment.
