7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award of a federal Demonstration Grant from the United States Department of**
9 **Health and Human Services Office of Child Support Enforcement (“U.S. OCSE”), in the**
10 **amount of \$83,330.00, with no local cash match requirement, for a Special Improvement**
11 **Program for custodial and non-custodial parents, and involving various agency**
12 **partnerships within the County, for the period 9/1/10 through 8/31/13, and appropriating**
13 **these funds through 12/31/10, for the Prosecutor’s Child Support Enforcement Agency,**
14 **and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor’s Child Support Enforcement Agency has received a federal
17 Demonstration Grant award of from the U.S. OCSE in the amount of \$83,330.00, with no local
18 cash match requirement, for a Special Improvement Program for custodial and non-custodial
19 parents, and involving various agency partnerships within the County, for the period 9/1/10
20 through 8/31/13; and

22 WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to provide salary and benefits and other
23 operating expenses for an Outreach Coordinator to run a diversion program with the County of
24 Summit Domestic Relations Court in a partnership with other county agencies and programs that
25 will coordinate services that support the entire family; and

27 WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to provide funding to work with partnership
28 agencies including Workforce Development, local fatherhood initiatives, the University of
29 Akron, which, along with County of Summit offices, will aim to divert civil contempt findings
30 for nonpayment of support with the goal of improving the likelihood that parents will pay their
31 child support; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
34 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
35 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the U.S. OCSE,
36 and to appropriate these grant funds;


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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
