A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into agreements for the acquisition of a right-of-way for the improvement of the Northampton Road Bridge over Mud Run, located in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Council District 3, at a cost not to exceed \$1,624.04, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2011-073, this Council authorized agreements with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the improvement of the Northampton Road Bridge over Mud Run, Bridge No. CUY-027-0435, located in the City of Cuyahoga Falls (said improvement being referenced herein as the "Project"); and, also known by Ohio Department of Transportation Project ID number ("PID") 84446, and

WHEREAS, a right-of-way ("ROW") is needed for the Project; and

WHEREAS, 'a ROW acquisition is considered a "local cost" which must be borne in whole by the local public agency performing a project, in this case being the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of the subject ROW will promote proceeding with the Project to bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned right-of-way acquisition is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

In return for certain warranty deeds, temporary highway right-of-way easements ("ROW") are needed for the improvement of the Northampton Road Bridge over Mud Run, located in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Council District 3, ODOT PID 84446. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute agreements of purchase of said right-of-way, under which the owners of said right-of-way will be paid an amount not to exceed \$1,624.04, said owners and their respective payments (the negotiated value of their warranty deeds and temporary highway right-of-way being as follows:

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately allows the acquisition of a necessary right-of-way for a county highway improvement project.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
