SECTION 2 (Cont.)

- (c) The Tax Levy will be for a six-year period of time, beginning on the tax list and duplicate for the tax year 2012. The proceeds of the tax levy would be distributed
- to the County in 2013 through 2018, inclusive.

SECTION 3

In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer to certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the Tax Levy in the amount of 4.50 mills.

SECTION 4

Upon receipt of the County Fiscal Officer's certification and receipt of the SSAB's approval, this Council will consider for enactment legislation to submit the question of the Tax Levy to the voters at the November 8, 2011 general election.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to enable the County Fiscal Officer to calculate the amounts requested in Section 3 and to certify the question to the Board of Elections in time for the November 8, 2011 election.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and shall be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
