7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into various contracts, or extensions to**
8 **existing contracts, with employers for participation in the Subsidized Employment**
9 **Program, for the period of June 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011, utilizing formulary**
10 **Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds to fund the agreements, in a collective**
11 **amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
12 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the County's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") was
15 previously awarded a certain Temporary Assistance for Needy Family ("TANF") allocation in
16 the amount of \$556,292.00 by the State of Ohio to be used specifically for a Subsidized
17 Employment Program ("SEP") during the period of November 1, 2009 through September 30,
18 2010; and

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20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2010-042, this Council authorized the Executive
21 to enter into various contracts with employers for participation in the SEP program and
22 reimbursement of wages for employees hired thereunder, in a collective amount not to exceed
23 \$556,292; and

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25 WHEREAS, the State subsequently extended the timeframe to expend the
26 aforementioned SEP allocation to May 31, 2011, and this Council, pursuant to Resolution No.
27 2011-020, authorized the extension of the timeframe to enter into SEP agreements with
28 employers until May 31, 2011; and

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30 WHEREAS, although the State is not providing an additional allocation of SEP funding
31 beyond the period of May 31, 2011, due to success of the program and the emphasis on using
32 TANF funds for employment purposes from both the State and federal governments, DJFS
33 desires to utilize a portion of its formulary TANF allocation, in the amount of \$150,000.00 to
34 fund SEP agreements with employers for the period of June 1, 2011 through September 30,
35 2011; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council, after reviewing all pertinent information, finds it necessary,
38 and in the best interest of the County, to authorize the Executive to enter into various contracts,
39 or extensions to existing contracts, with employers for participation in the SEP program for the
40 period of June 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011, utilizing formulary TANF funds to fund the
41 agreements, in a collective amount not to exceed \$150,000.00;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
44 State of Ohio, that:

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48 The Executive is hereby authorized to enter into various contracts, or extensions to
49 existing contracts, with employers for participation in the SEP program for the period of June 1,
50 2011 through September 30, 2011, utilizing formulary TANF funds to fund the agreements, in a
51 collective amount not to exceed \$150,000.00.

7 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to allow the
8 Executive to enter the aforementioned SEP agreements in a timely manner and to properly and
9 timely expend TANF funds.

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
14 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be
15 in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to
20 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
22 meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the
23 Ohio Revised Code.
