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7 **An Ordinance amending the 2011 Report on Staffing and making certain amendments to the**
8 **Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to reflect the consolidation of the Department of**
9 **Law and the Department of Insurance and Risk Management into the Department of Law,**
10 **Insurance and Risk Management, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Executive's Director of the Department of Insurance and Risk Management,
13 recently resigned from employment with the County; and

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15 WHEREAS, in lieu of replacing the Director of the Department of Insurance and Risk
16 Management, the Executive intends to consolidate the functions of that Department with the
17 Executive's Department of Law, thereby creating the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk
18 Management under the direction of the existing Director of the Department of Law; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Executive further proposes to hire a full-time unclassified Deputy Director
21 of Employee Benefits that will report to the Director of the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk
22 Management and will oversee and coordinate employee health insurance and similar matters; and

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24 WHEREAS, the Executive also proposes to transition the existing Deputy Director of the
25 Department of Insurance into the Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability that will report
26 to the Director of the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management and will oversee matters
27 pertaining to property and casualty insurance, liability issues and similar matters; and

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29 WHEREAS, the actions proposed by the Executive will serve to reduce salary expenditures,
30 the size of senior staff in the Executive's Office and will further the purpose of government
31 consolidation; and

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33 WHEREAS, to accomplish the aforementioned changes, an amendment is necessary to the
34 2011 Report on Staffing; and

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36 WHEREAS, the aforementioned changes necessitate certain amendments to the Codified
37 Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that
40 it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend the 2011 Report on
41 Staffing and to further make certain necessary amendments to the Codified Ordinances of the County
42 of Summit.

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44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of
45 Ohio, that:

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47 SECTION 1

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49 The 2011 Report on Staffing, adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2010-476 is hereby amended as
50 follows:

5 <u>Deputy Director- Insurance Property, Casualty & Liability</u>	1
6 <u>Director of Insurance and Risk Management</u>	1
7 <u>Director of Law, Insurance and Risk Management</u>	1

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9 SECTION 2

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11 The Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit are hereby amended to replace any
12 reference to the "Department of Law" and "Department of Insurance and Risk Management" with
13 the "Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management." The Codified Ordinances of the County
14 of Summit are also hereby amended to replace any reference to the "Director of Insurance and Risk
15 Management" and "Director of Law" with "Director of Law, Insurance and Risk Management."
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17 SECTION 3

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19 This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
20 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to
21 immediately make the necessary changes to the 2011 Report on Staffing and Codified Ordinances to
22 reflect the organization of the Executive's Office.
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24 SECTION 4

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26 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
27 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
28 force at the earliest time provided by law.
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30 SECTION 5

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32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the
33 adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of
34 this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the
35 public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
