7 **A Resolution appropriating an additional award of \$50,000.00 in Workforce Investment**
8 **Act (“WIA”) federal grant funds, for the Youth Employment for Success (“YES”)**
9 **Program, received from the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services (“DJFS”),**
10 **with no local cash match requirement, and adjusting existing YES appropriations in the**
11 **amount of \$2,900.00, for the period 7/1/11 through 9/30/11, for the Executive’s Department**
12 **of Communications, YES Department, and declaring an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, with the intent to adjust the Department of Communications’ YES Program,
15 which is funded with federal grants, to operate on the Federal Fiscal Year (“FFY”), being
16 October 1 through September 30, DJFS has granted an additional award in the amount of
17 \$50,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, as well as adjusting existing YES
18 appropriations in the amount of \$2,900.00, for the transition into this new fiscal reporting year;

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21 WHEREAS, this professional services award of \$50,000.00 was accepted by the County
22 of Summit Board of Control at its meeting held 6/1/11, subject to confirmation by County
23 Council; and

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25 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2011-239 was introduced 6/6/11 to confirm the award of
26 \$50,000.00 for the YES In-school Youth program; and

28 WHEREAS, the original award for this YES program was accepted and appropriated in
29 Resolution No. 2010-298, with carryover Resolution No. 2010-529 for the period ending 6/30/11
30 in the amount of \$200,000.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

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32 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
33 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned
34 additional funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 and to adjust the existing appropriations in the
35 amount of \$2,900.00;
