7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with**
8 **Medina County, Ohio, setting forth the roles and responsibilities of the parties in the**
9 **governance and operation of the Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) Local Area 2/20,**
10 **including the Workforce Investment Board (“WIB”) governing said Local Area 2/20, for**
11 **the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and County of Medina are committed to determining
14 and planning for the highest quality of life for the citizens of both Summit County, Ohio and
15 Medina County, Ohio; and

17 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and County of Medina want to assure the most
18 efficient and effective usage of public dollars received through allocations under the Workforce
19 Investment Act (“WIA”) of 1998 to serve the citizens of Summit County, Ohio and Medina
20 County, Ohio; and

22 WHEREAS, WIA programs and services are provided in Summit County, through the
23 County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services (“CSDJFS”) and in Medina County,
24 through the Medina Office of Workforce Development and each County acts as a separate entity;
25 and

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27 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has created 20 Workforce Investment Service Delivery
28 Areas and designated the area comprised of the counties of Summit and Medina as Area 20 for
29 financial purposes and as Area 2 for program purposes (hereinafter referred to as “Local Area
30 2/20”); and

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32 WHEREAS, each County desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the
33 purpose of defining the rights and responsibilities of each party, to identify the authority of the
34 Chief Local Elected Officials in each County, and to acknowledge the appointment process for
35 membership and overall role of Local Area 2/20’s Workforce Investment Board (“WIB”); and

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37 WHEREAS, under said Intergovernmental Agreement, CSDJFS, will serve as Fiscal
38 Agent and the recipient of WIA allocations for Local Area 2; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute an
42 Intergovernmental Agreement with Medina County, Ohio, setting forth the roles and
43 responsibilities of the parties in the governance and operation of the Workforce WIA Local Area
44 2/20, including the WIB governing Local Area 2/20.

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
47 State of Ohio, that:

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49 SECTION 1

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51 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement
52 with Medina County, Ohio, setting forth the roles and responsibilities of the parties in the

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
14 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
15 authorize the Executive to execute said agreement so that WIA Local Area 2/20 will be
16 effectively operated and governed.

18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
