7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept a fiscal year 2011 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) from**  
9 **the City of Akron, in the amount of \$39,348.54, with no local cash match requirement, with**  
10 **a performance period from 10/1/11 through 9/30/14, and appropriating these grant funds**  
11 **for the period 10/1/11 through 12/31/11, for the Executive’s Department of Law, Insurance**  
12 **and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety/Justice Affairs, and declaring an**  
13 **emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the City of Akron had applied for and received a fiscal year 2011 JAG grant  
16 from the United States Department of Justice (“DOJ”) for the development and enhancement of  
17 programs within the criminal justice system; and

19 WHEREAS, the County Executive’s Department of Law, Insurance and Risk  
20 Management – Division of Public Safety/Justice Affairs and the County Sheriff have agreed to  
21 participate as partner agencies in this program and receive a pass-through JAG from the City of  
22 Akron’s award; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
25 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to  
26 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the City  
27 of Akron, and to appropriate these grant funds;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

34 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
35 the fiscal year 2011 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) grant award from  
36 the City of Akron, for the period 10/1/11 through 9/30/14, in the amount of \$39,348.54, with no  
37 local cash match requirement.
